. Reopening of part of the accommodation units will be available for 2023 bookings

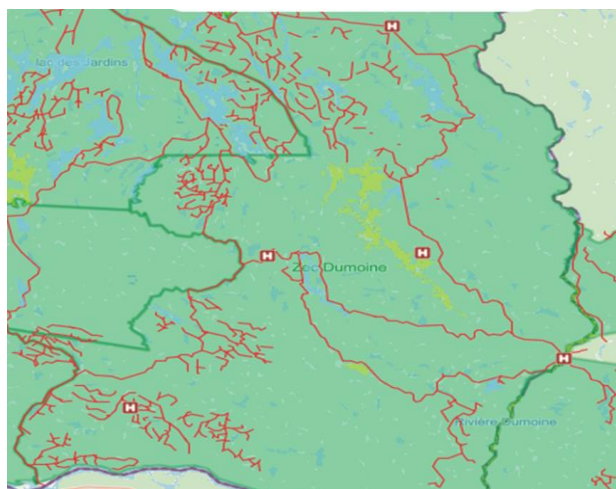

Reminder of a few rules

IMPORTANT - CAMPING

Check with the administrative office for the regulation of the campsite #05-2018 in force on the Zec Dumoine <https://zecdumoine.reseazec.com/camping-reglements-05-2018> and the applicable regulations established by the MFFP <https://mffp.gouv.qc.ca/la-faune/territoires-fauniques/camping-zecs/>.

Due to covid, the upgrading of campgrounds has been extended and must be completed by July 2023. A new committee for the upgrading of campsites has been formed in 2020 and they will continue to follow up on the files **We would like to congratulate all the campers who have collaborated in the smooth running of the upgrading of their camping equipment and / or accessories.**

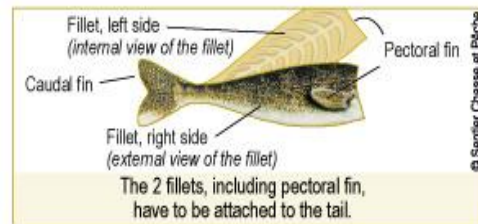
Baitfish prohibited on the territory (minnows and other)

Leeches and worms (alive or dead) are allowed.

Walleye, size to respect (37 to 53CM) and portfolio fillets

It is not permitted to catch and keep or to have in your possession **walleye** of less than **37 cm** or more than **53 cm** from lakes in Dumoine Zec. The walleye should be transported whole or in **fillets as described below**. This allows for the identification

of the species and the determination of the total length. The **two fillets** must measure more than **28 cm** and less than **40 cm** long. These must be measured from the tip of the tail to the inside of the pectoral fin. Fillets must be connected by the caudal fin (tail). The pectoral fins and the skin must adhere to the filet.



Lake trout and splake trout

Please note that the daily limit and possession for all Quebec (except where specified) is now two (2) lake trout. See section “special regulations 2023” for lakes of exceptions authorizing capture of a **total combination** of 3 splake and/or lake trout.

POLICY – NOTIFICATION AND POSTING FOR BEAR HUNTING

A map will be available at the Zec Dumoine office which indicates baited locations for bear hunting. For the safety of all users, all hunters must notify the office where they have baited and post on the road that they have baited the area.

Registration, pricing and access permit - Mandatory at any time (12 months per year)

All year long, it is mandatory to register to access the territory and you must leave your registration record when you exit. Furthermore, every person who wants to circulate or to practice an activity, must pay the current pricing.

Not submitting your completed registration with date/time and specifics constitutes an offence punishable by fine.



It is possible to register at the registration office located at 3, rue Principale in Rapides-des-Joachims and Zec Restigo or by using online registration service (see following note).

Online registration service - (PAV)

It is possible to purchase packages and register via the online registration service (PAV) on www.zecdumoine.reseauzec.com

Please note that administration fees will be applied with the purchase of packages made through the online registration service.

To register by PAV - It is possible to print your registration up to five days before your arrival.

Date and time of access: It is mandatory to validate your arrival and departure, to do this, you have access to a **timestamp** at the registration of the Zec **to punch your slip when arriving and leaving** or check in with an employee of the Zec.

According to the regulation regarding hunting and fishing ZEC, Law C - 61.1, r. 78, section 3 - 4th paragraph (this proof of registration duly completed shall be returned when leaving at the registration station);

For those who arrive by plane or other similar way, **a maximum deadline of 48 hours will be allowed for delivery of duly completed registration sheet**. After this period, your registration will not be valid and will constitute a breach.

Options for package purchase :

- 1- Zec Restigo reception - 10 % service fee.
- 2- On line with the online registration service (PAV) - 3 % software adm. fees
- 3- Zec Dumoine office (3 rue Principale) at no additional charge or by E-transfer

Lakes : Benwah, du Milieu and Head (1)	Limit and possession : four (4) speckle trout
<u>New regulation</u> Lakes: West, Spring, Arc-en-ciel et Pinguet. (1)	Open every day between May 12 th and September 25 th until the annual quota determined by the DGFa -08 is reached. Limit and possession: four (4) speckle trout
<u>New regulation</u> Lakes: Rosemond, Yves, de l'Orme and Blackburn (1)	Open every day between May 12th and September 25th, until the annual quota determined by the DGFa-08 is reached.
Lakes: Back Camp, Wilson and Patterson (1)	Fly-fishing only.
Lakes : Sangsues, Malouin and Paul-Joncas	Lake trout open from May 12th to July 31st, inclusively. Limit and possession: two (2) lake trout
Lake Ramé	Lake trout open from May 12th to July 1st inclusively. All other species: open from May 19th to July 1st inclusively.
Lakes: Chaîne 3, Fripp, Sauvole, Madill, Hanwell, Oriole, Salampar and Stubbs (2)	Limit and possession: lake trout and splake trout, total of 3 combined.

- (1) - When the quota of a lake is reached, the lake is closed for fishing.
(2) - Exception lakes for splake and lake trout.
